PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING PROPOSED
FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 BUDGET
April 24, 2017 at 6:30 p.m.

The Village Board of Waterman held a public hearing on April 24, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. regarding the proposed 2017-2018 budget. Roll called showed Ekle, Beach, Robinson, and Lieving present.

Trustee Stanley arrived at 6:36 p.m.

The public hearing was opened at 6:32 p.m., Mayor Ekle explained the procedures and asked for anyone wishing to speak to stand and be sworn in. There were no interested parties.

Finance Chair Beach commented on the 2017-2018 proposed budget as follows:

Final figures were submitted earlier in the day and updates were provided to the Board. Once all transfers had been from savings were made, there was a small surplus. The cuts that were originally made in Parks and Buildings & Grounds were mostly restored. All the street projects were financed. The crack seal project was reduced from 30K to 20K. All employees received a 3% raise. Health insurance benefits for full-time employees were increased to \$9,000. The revenue projects were conservative. There will be issues as we go along and hopefully all will be covered.

No public sworn in, no public comment, the public portion of the hearing is closed at 6:37 p.m.

With no further comments, Mayor Ekle closed the public hearing at 6:38 p.m.
