



The Waterman Board of Trustees and Village President are announcing the Waterman Village Hall will close at 1:00 p.m. on Friday March 20, 2020 and remain closed until March 30, 2020. During the week you may use the drop box at Village Hall, which will be monitored daily. The Police Department and Public Works will operate as usual. Please contact the Village President or any Village Board member with any concerns.

Beginning March 30, 2020 Waterman Village Hall will be staffed and available for phone and email services only. Minimizing the exposure and spread of COVID-19 is crucial. In-person meetings and services will be by appointment only and follow “best practices” outlined by the Center for Disease Control (CDC), local, and state leaders. This may change in the coming weeks. We will continue to monitor the situation closely and communicate any changes appropriately.

Meeting the health, safety, and service needs of Waterman and our staff are of the greatest importance. The Waterman Police Department will continue to provide services as outlined by Chief Cicci previously. Public works will continue to maintain the village infrastructure and services as required.
